













































































## State Complaint **Due Process** 1. Parents of a child, an adult Any individual or student (age 18 or older), or an LEA may file. organization may file. Disputes about the Allegations of procedural violations of IDEA, Article 9 of the NC General Statutes 115C, and/or identification, evaluation, educational placement of a child with a disability, FAPE, or a manifestation determination. 4. Must try to resolve in a May resolve by meeting together or via mediation. resolution meeting or mediation. 7. Must file within one Must file within one calendar year of disputed activity. calendar year of alleged violation.

## State Complaint

- Sixty (60) calendar days for investigation to be completed and report sent to you and the LEA.
- Decision made by NCDPI staff after investigation of evidence.
- 8. Decision is final and cannot be appealed.

## **Due Process**

- Resolution period 30 days if making progress. 45 days for hearing and decision. (Hearing officer can grant an extension of the timeline.)
- 7. Decision by impartial Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) after a hearing.
- Decision is final unless appealed.
