Because you are a parent involved in a special education due process complaint (hearing), the Department must tell you about any free or low-cost legal and other relevant services that may be available to you. You are not required to have a lawyer or other representation for the due process hearing; however, if you want assistance, these services may be available. Feel free to contact the agencies listed below. Each agency has its own rules for client eligibility. Some of these agencies have income and/or asset limitations, and some do not. Some of these agencies may charge a small fee or a sliding-scale fee for their services. Each agency will determine whether it will be able to assist you. Additionally, the Area Education Agency (AEA) may know of other lawyers in your area who may be able to assist you. Finally, you may wish to look in the "attorneys" or "lawyers" section of the telephone directory. Many lawyers offer free first office visits.

Within five business days of the Department receiving the request for a hearing, the Department will contact you about your availability for a telephone conference call. If you do not have access to a phone, you will be contacted by mail.
