

STATEWIDE SYSTEM



- Formed 1996
- Wrote mediation statute (WI § 115.797)
- · Reviews external evaluation
- Considers new DR options and other system issues
- · Participates in roster training



STATEWIDE SYSTEM

WSEMS Roster of Neutrals

- WSEMS Partners select 23 neutrals on roster
- Stakeholders included in roster training:
 - 5-day initial training
 - Required annual training
- Impartiality
- Diversity
- · Same roster for mediation & facilitation

IEP FACILITATION

- External facilitators (WSEMS neutrals)
- For any IEP meeting
- Request Joint or individual
- Voluntary
- · Participants:
 - IEP team
- Facilitator (not part of team)
- 3 hour limit
- Free

MEDIATION

- Use roster mediators
- · Issues involving:
 - evaluation, eligibility, IEP,
 Agreement to mediate placement & FAPE
- resolution meeting waiver
- Written request joint/single Written agreement
- Voluntary
- Free
- · No time limit
- Participants 2 each (may include attorneys)
- confidentiality provision
- enforceable under WI contract law



- Intake, screening, analysis
- · Data collection
- · System evaluation

Intake/Screening

- Educational/Analytical
- Verifying facts
- · Screen for components required by law, abuse, complications, other ongoing legal processes
- History
- Brokering/Convening to the table







- Wisconsin receives approximately 80-90 complaints per year
- Wisconsin consistently meets the target of 100% set for this indicator

INDICATOR 17

Due Process Hearing System

- · Structure of Wisconsin's System
- Wisconsin receives approximately 35 hearing requests per year
- The vast majority of requests resolve without a hearing
- Wisconsin consistently meets the target of 100% for this indicator



INDICATOR 19

Mediation System

- Wisconsin conducts approximately 40-70 mediations per year
- Wisconsin consistently exceeds the targets set by our stakeholders for this indicator
