Resolution Meeting Facilitation (RMF)

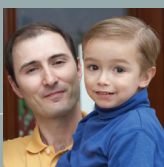
The **first 30 days** after a parent requests due process is considered a **resolution period**. A **Resolution Meeting** must be held, unless both sides agree to waive it or agree to mediation instead. If both parties believe a neutral third party at the Resolution Meeting will increase the likelihood of reaching agreement, ODR will send a facilitator free of charge.

The **facilitator** will ...

- Help the parties focus on the student
- Maintain impartiality
- Strive for open communication
- Help to resolve disagreements

Benefits of RMF can include:

- Improved relationships between parents and school representatives
- Identification of new options to address unresolved issues
- Improved chances of reaching agreement, making a stressful and costly due process hearing unnecessary
